Four New Jersey Lottery Tickets Win \$50,000 as Powerball Jackpot Rolls to \$343,000,000

TRENTON (Jan. 21, 2020) – Four New Jersey Lottery tickets sold that matched four of the five white balls and the Powerball drawn for the **Saturday, Jan. 18 drawing** winning the **\$50,000** third-tier prize. The winning tickets from Saturday night's drawing were sold at the following locations:

- **Bergen County: Quick Chek #137, 116 Route 46 East, Lodi;**
- **Cape May County: Glick's Corner Café & Deli, 1270 Route 9 South, Cape May Court House;**
- **Morris County: Boonton Liquor Locker, 119 Hawkins Place, Boonton; and**
- **Salem County: Sunoco, 327 Slapes Corner Rd., Carneys Point.**

The **winning numbers** for the **Saturday, Jan. 18**, drawing were: **20, 24, 38, 56 and 68**. The **Red Power Ball number** was **18**. The **Multiplier number** was **02**. In addition to the third-tier prizewinning tickets sold, there were 47,824 New Jersey players who took home an estimated \$234,727 in prizes ranging from \$4 to \$200, according to Lottery Acting Executive Director James Carey. The Powerball jackpot rolls to \$343,000,000 for the next drawing to be held Wednesday, Jan. 22, at 10:59 pm.
