Triple the Treat: Three Players Split Cash 5 Jackpot

Players From Union, Morris and Hunterdon Counties to Share \$650,466 Prize

TRENTON (April 9, 2025) – Three New Jersey Lottery players pulled off the unlikely, all matching the five numbers to stake a claim to the Jersey Cash 5 jackpot. The winners were from Morris, Union and Hunterdon counties and they will each receive \$216,822 from the \$650,466 jackpot.

The jackpot was the 16th hit of 2025 and the third to be split. The winning numbers were **03, 06, 08, 10, 11**. The Xtra was **02** and the Bullseye was **03**. In addition to the jackpot, 83 players matched four balls and the Bullseye to each win \$500 and 33 players matched four balls, the Bullseye and the Xtra to each win \$500.

The last time three players split a Cash 5 jackpot was Oct. 31, 2024, with each winner pocketing \$55,602 from a \$166,806 jackpot.

Each retailer will receive a \$2,000 bonus for selling the winning tickets. The locations were:
