Warren County Player Wins \$1 Million Scratch-Off

Power 20X Haul Is Third of Game's Three Top Prizes

TRENTON (May 5, 2025) – A New Jersey Lottery Scratch-Off player won a \$1 million top prize, and two others won the first two top prizes in a recently launched version of the \$250,000 Crossword.

Last week's big winners:

- **April 30: Power 20X, \$1,000,000.** The third of three top prizes for the \$20 ticket was purchased at Paul Mart, 462 South Main Street in Phillipsburg, Warren County.
- **April 28 and May 1: \$250,000 Crossword, \$250,000:** This version of the game was issued March 19. On April 28, a winning ticket was purchased at Webster Liquor & Deli, 4 Webster Avenue, in Hudson County's Jersey City. The other was sold May 1 at Stop & Shop #810, 1600 Perrineville Road, Monroe Township, Middlesex County.
